Release of Liability and Promise Not to Sue. I want my daughter to participate in some or all of Carnegie Mellon University's ("CMU") Creative Technology Nights and related activities (collectively, "TechNights"). In return for the opportunity for my daughter to participate in TechNights, I, on behalf of myself and my daughter, release CMU and anyone acting on CMU's behalf (such as teachers and staff) from any liability of any kind connected with my daughter's participation in TechNights.
